The National Council on Economic Education is inviting you to take part in an *NCEE Study Tour for Economic Educators to the United States*. The tour will take place from **May 9 through May 24, 2007**. We are also inviting your colleague Thia Jasmina to accompany you on this tour.

Following your arrival in New York City for a brief orientation, you will travel to Baylor University in Waco, Texas for a week-long tour including meetings with American academics, business leaders, and school teachers, administrators and students to learn about how economic education is delivered in the United States. After a week in Texas, you will return to Washington DC for a debriefing session and to meet with members of Congress and their staff.

Because it may be necessary to slightly adjust the study tour start and finish dates due to the availability of flights, we recommend that, when applying for your U.S. visa, you indicate your travel will take place from **May 6 through May 27, 2007**.

NCEE will make all arrangements for your international, and domestic (within the United States) travel and will coordinate all logistics regarding your accommodations for your entire visit. **Please do not make any travel arrangements yourself.** All transportation, single-entry visa costs, health insurance, food and lodging costs will be covered by the National Council on Economic Education through a grant provided by the U.S. Department of Education in cooperation with the U.S. Department of State. **In order to take part in this series tour, you will need a currently valid international passport.**
